Ho Family Foundation and the American Council of Learned Societies, Arizona State University offers a week-long workshop on teaching about Buddhism at the post-secondary level to facilitate new scholarly networks in this field. The workshop focuses on recent developments in the study of and teaching about Theravada Buddhism in South and Southeast Asia. Interdisciplinary approaches in textual and ethnographic studies in premodern/modern contexts as well as teaching undergraduates about Buddhist histories and practices, changing academic environments and student demographics will be discussed in workshop sessions.
