

THE LUDO AND ROSANE ROCHER FOUNDATION

Subvention Program for First Books

The Ludo and Rosane Rocher Foundation is creating a program that will provide subventions for the publication of "first books" by young scholars in the field of classical Indology. The scholars are expected to submit a CV, a book title, summary, and table of contents to the Foundation, with a list of potential publishers. These should be academic presses: either US university presses or the US offices of foreign academic presses, such as Oxford University Press. Upon preliminary approval, the author will send the full manuscript for review. Once a book has been approved by the Foundation, it will provide a subvention of \$ 5000 to the press that undertakes to publish it. It will be the responsibility of the author to find a suitable press. This program is intended to support young scholars in the early years of their postdoctoral academic life. The published book must carry on the Copyright page the acknowledgment: "Published with the support of the Ludo and Rosane Rocher Foundation."
